### The Shape of Light workshop

The focus will be on painting coastal life with an emphasis on playing within the structure of light and shadow.

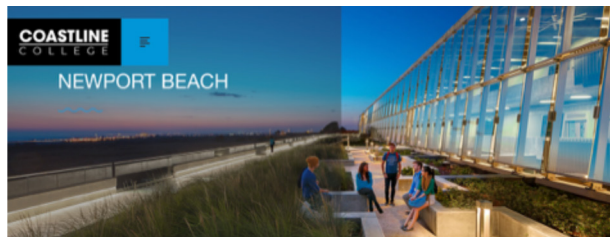
Students will learn how, and when, to employ spontaneous "one go" calligraphy, splattering, and dry brush, against soft washes that will bring their watercolors to life.

Through the process of demonstrations, exercises, and paint-along sessions, students will fine tune their sense of values that will create the illusion of light and atmosphere.

Workshop photographic references as well as a supply list will be available to registered participants before the workshop date to provide ample time to gather materials.
